

2019 SJMTA Student Musicales:
Romantic Period Style throughout the 19th Century

- Purpose** This thematic forum is open to young pianists, string & woodwind students, as well as singers of all levels of development, without auditions.
- Date** **Sunday February 17, 2019** at Jacobs Music in Cherry Hill.
There will be three recitals to accommodate all performers, 12:30pm, 2:00pm and 3:30pm.
- Theme** Romantic Period Style throughout the 19th Century.
Romantic Period Composers: Schubert, Schumann, Mendelssohn, Chopin, Liszt, Brahms and others (see list of composers on p. 6)
- Requirements** Requirements:
- Participating student(s) must study with an SJMTA member teacher.
 - Member teachers are free to submit any or all of their students to this event.
 - Each participant may perform one solo composition and/or one duet with another student.
 - Memorization is required for solo compositions only. Failure to abide by any of the guidelines will result in a teacher's ineligibility to submit students the following year.
- Fees** Registration Fees: \$15 for each piece entered, whether solo or duet. If a student is playing a solo and a duet, the student will need to pay \$15 for the solo piece, plus \$7.50 for half of the duet fee.
Duty Deposit: We require all participating teachers to pay \$50 "duty deposit" or volunteer their time on the day of the event.
Important: No refunds will be given once registrations have been submitted.
